The winning score came with only 3 seconds left, as May fumbled as they crossed the goal line, but it was ruled a touchdown.

Craig Steele had a hand in eleven touchdowns, throwing for eight, rushing for two, and returning a punt for another. He had over 400 total yards passing.

In the same district, Petey Salaiz rushed for 480 yards

on 39 carries to boost Mullin to a 66-16 victory over rival Zephyr. Salaiz rushed for eight td's, passed for another, and kicked 6 pat's to account for all of Mullin's scoring.

Covington scored with eleven seconds to go to stay in the playoff hunt and beat Milford 30-29. Milford had the ball and a 29-24 lead with less than a minute remaining. with third and one. Covington's Charlie Tingle stripped the ball from Milford's Kinta Cook to set up the final score.
